Financial Implications: (Must include comments of the PCC's Chief Finance Officer where the decision has financial implications)

A current pressure is noted within the DSE budget and is forecasting a significant pressure due to overtime incurred whilst carrying out ongoing investigations. This pressure is exacerbated by staff shortages within the team. It should be noted that the DBS income stream regularly over achieves its budget. This financial year DBS income has a year to date over achievement of £41k income against a £271k budget and the release of £14,500 from this income will cover the costs of the disclosure team's overtime pressure. The current pressure has arisen due to the volume of disclosures received and on-going commitments, the impact of which is that overtime is needed and this drives up costs. However, as overtime is claimed as part of the scheme's monthly return, the income received will increase in proportion to the amount of the overtime claimed. In summary, increased costs will be recovered by increased income.
