# **Executive Summary:**

The original capital bid (£109k) for the Radio Tactics - ACESO network solution was approved November 2014. The new solution is a stand alone kiosk which can run independently and have no impact on the Force network. However, in order to realise the full benefit the force needs an integrated solution and this means plugging it into the network. Following receipt of national guidance the Information Security Officer regards this as introducing an 'untrusted source' onto the network as the content on the device (CCTV files, phone data, etc) could be corrupted and without protection thereby giving rise to a potential security risk.

To ensure compliance with PSNP additional security network equipment is required to build an element of firewalling between the device and the network so its content can be cleared before acceptance.

The implementation of this operational facility and training of staff is currently on hold pending the additional security measures.
