Title: NHS England Sexual Assault and Abuse (SAAS) Fund 2021-2022

Executive Summary:

NHS England announced an opportunity for PCC's to apply for non-recurrent funding to enable specialist sexual assault services to apply for non-recurrent funding for 2021/22 to support delivery of work in support of NHS England's Sexual Assault and Abuse Strategy.

The PCC was successful in securing £49,410 which will be allocated as below:

A Way Out - £28,081

A Way Out will use proactive outreach with gender and trauma informed support to meet the needs of women (13 to 25) whose experience and/or fear of abuse, harm, sexual assault and exploitation (including previous trauma) negatively impacts on their behaviour and relationships and is a cause and/or consequence of the challenges they face (such as addiction, victim and/or perpetrator of crime, homelessness, learning difficulties/disabilities, mental and/or physical ill health, poverty etc).

Arch Teesside - £8,720 as per below:

Arch will roll out pre-trial therapy training for health and other professionals across Tees. The training has been CPD accredited and will be delivered by a BACP accredited therapist with expertise in sexual violence and direct experience of working to the protocol. Due to uncertainty around Covid restrictions the training will be offered online.
